

Board Briefings

ITEMS FROM THE SCHOOL BOARD'S TUESDAY, AUG. 8 MEETING:

- SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT The district has recently hired outstanding individuals for various positions and was fortunate to have a large, well-qualified applicant pool from which to choose, said Superintendent Michael Cornell. He also reported that the School Board's summer retreat focused on coherence. A two-day administrative retreat with Harvey Silver, a nationally recognized education presenter/trainer, will also occur this month. Department leaders will be included on one of those days. Dr. Silver will be the keynote speaker on Staff Opening Day in September.
- 2017-18 TAX RATES The 2017-18 tax levy of \$34,946,164 was approved. This is the second consecutive year with a decrease in the levy, which is the amount collected from taxpayers to support the school district budget. The following 2017-18 school tax rates were established: Hamburg, \$35.37 per \$1,000 assessed valuation, a *decrease* of 96 cents per \$1,000; Eden, \$29.19, a *decrease* of 89 cents; Boston, \$21.14, an increase of 21 cents; Orchard Park, \$35.37, a *decrease* of 62 cents. Boston's tax rate increase is due to the equalization rate set by the state for that town.
