ITEMS FROM THE SCHOOL BOARD'S SEPT. 1 SPECIAL MEETING (conducted remotely via Webex)

• 100% REMOTE LEARNING TEACHER AGREEMENT — A memorandum of agreement between the district and Hamburg Teachers' Association (HTA) for the delivery of instruction under the 100% remote learning option was unanimously approved. The agreement spells out the process for teacher assignments and other details. HTA members selected to fill a 100% remote learning position would receive a stipend for teaching during a lunch or planning period, four days a week, with planning taking place on Wednesdays. They would continue to fulfill their regular duties. The agreement expires on June 30, 2021. Also approved was a separate agreement with the HTA regarding the voluntary transfer process for assignments for the 2021-2022 school year.

• **CODE OF CONDUCT 2020-21** — The district's 2020-21 Code of Conduct was approved. It has revisions pertaining to compliance with health and safety protocols during the pandemic. The code will now also apply to all off-campus learning.

• **PERSONNEL** — The board approved the appointments of Brendan McFall, social studies teacher (part-time) and Carolyn Haggerty, special education teacher (part-time), both at the Middle School, effective Sept. 1.
