- Once programs begin, there are no refunds except those for verified medical conditions.

ENTERING OUR SCHOOLS

For summer instrumental programs, entry will be through the main doors of District buildings, unless otherwise directed by the program coordinator. 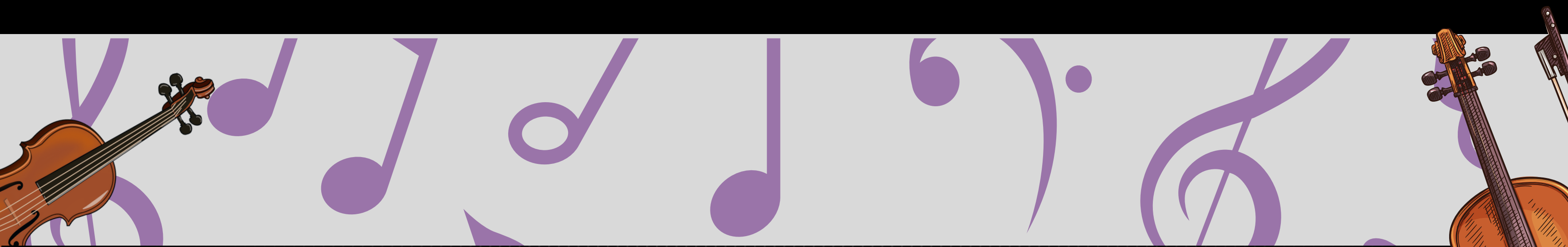

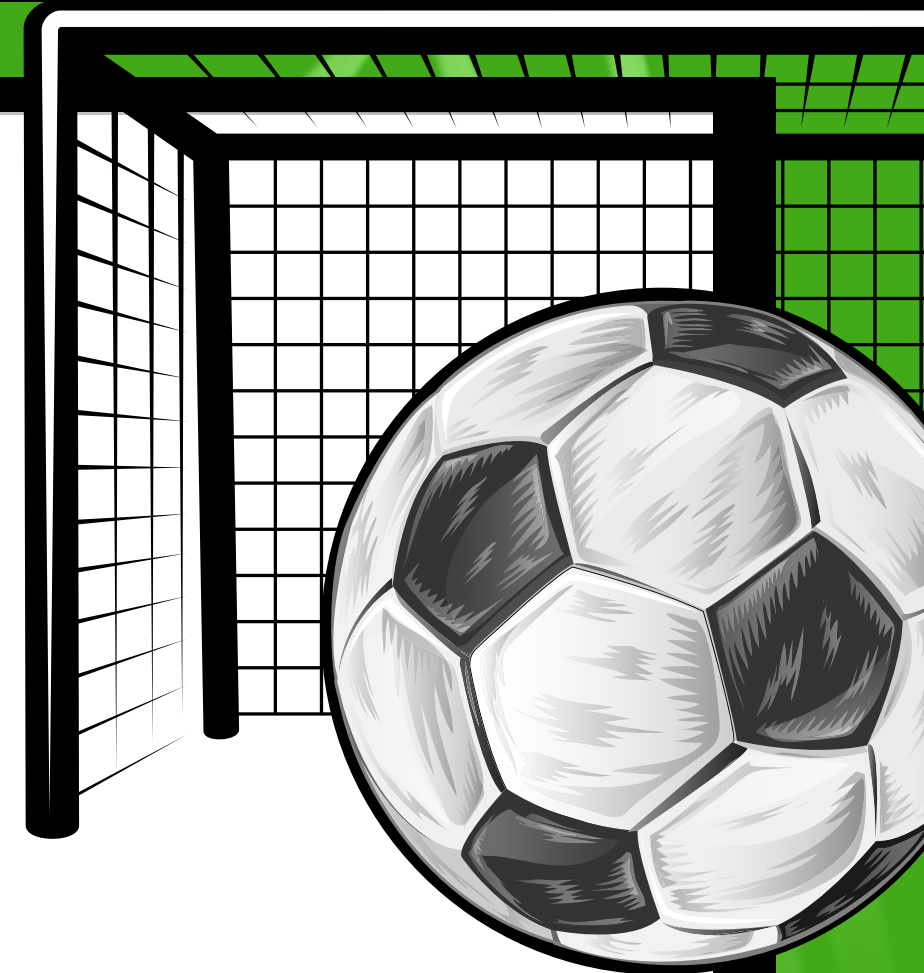

It's important to emphasize the importance of safety and injury prevention. Your child should properly warm-up and stretch before each practice, wear appropriate clothing and shoes, and communicate any pain or discomfort to the coaches. Overall, the summer practice program is a great opportunity for your child to improve their skills, bond with their teammates and prepare for the upcoming cheerleading season. 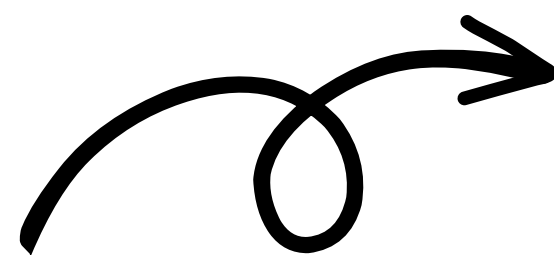

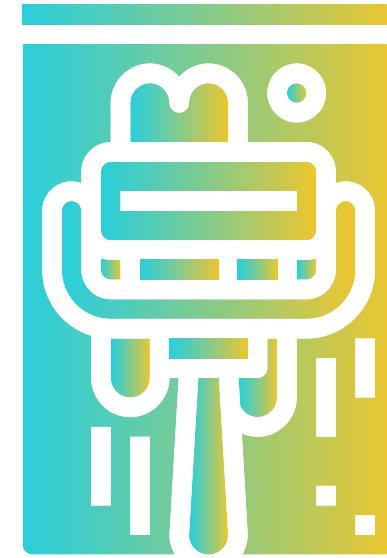
