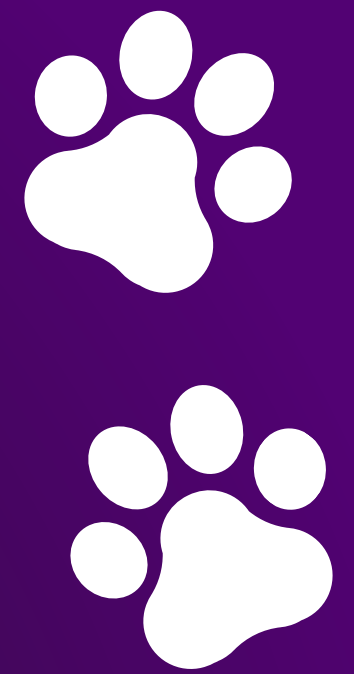

- Community Education activities will be cancelled when regular school day sessions are cancelled due to holidays, inclement weather, or other emergencies. We will do our best to reschedule classes due to weather-related cancellations, but only as space and time allows. No refunds will be made for cancelled classes.
- Once programs begin, there are no refunds except those for verified medical conditions.

ENTERING OUR SCHOOLS

As part of the district's security protocol, only certain exterior school doors will be unlocked for summer programming participants to gain entry to programs. For summer instrumental programs, entry will be through the main doors of District buildings, unless otherwise directed by the program coordinator. For athletic programs, participant entry will occur through door #30 (gym door) off the Legion Drive parking lot. For educational programming, please enter Hamburg High School's main entrance door.

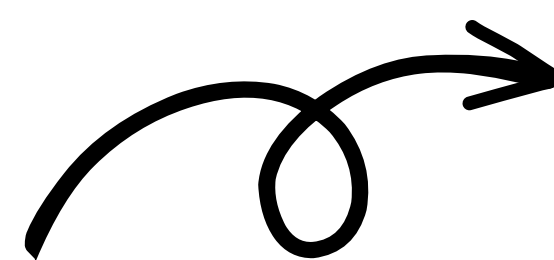
Session 4: August 3rd - UPES Giving Garden

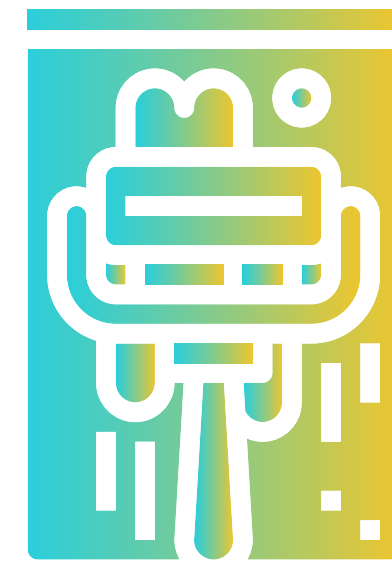
